Welcome new students!

A warm welcome to SLU and Campus Ultuna! My name is Esbjörn EXCELSIOR Montelius Risberg and I am the President of the Ultuna Student Union 2026. It is the Ultuna Student Union, also called the Union or ULS, that organizes your two "småttingveckorna" (orientation weeks) at the beginning of the semester, introducing you to campus life at Ultuna.

The orientation weeks are designed to give you as a new student the best possible start to your student life. You will have the chance to get to know the campus, all the other new students, those of us who are already studying here, as well as everything else important that comes with student life—but above all, to have a lot of fun. The schedule for the orientation weeks is, as far as possible, coordinated with the university to give you all the chance to participate in as much as you want.

When you arrive at Ultuna on Monday, August 31st, you will have the opportunity to enroll in the Ultuna Student Union, but you can already become a member online! Through membership, you get to participate in all activities during the orientation weeks, as well as the rest of the year. These activities can be anything from sports practice, formal dinners (*sittningar*), choir singing, board game nights, crafting meetups, career fairs, and the opportunity to become a union official and get involved in one of our committees.

Besides fun activities, the Union also conducts educational monitoring at SLU and ensures that your education maintains high quality throughout your time studying. Educational monitoring is the very reason the Union exists, and it is the Union's most important task. Unlike elementary and high school, students at a university or college have a legal right to be represented in all the different decision-making bodies at the university. The Union is our collective voice directed at SLU, where we work both proactively to develop the education and reactively when something isn't working. Is the air quality in the lecture halls too poor for you to concentrate on your work? Are you not getting your exam results back in time to pass the course before CSN is paid out? Is the course director late to every lecture? That is just a small sample of the issues you can turn to the Union with!

During the orientation weeks, there are many opportunities to party, and it is important to emphasize that all alcohol consumption is completely voluntary. No one should ever feel pressured to drink alcohol against their will, and you always have the right to say no. If you do choose to drink alcohol, that is completely fine, but then "every other water" is a good rule of thumb to stick to.

If you experience pressure to drink alcohol, or if you ever feel uncomfortable or subjected to something you don't like, you can talk to a Class Mentor (*Klassfadder*), Head Mentor (*Hufvudfadder*) Elvira Schackenberg Gudmundsson, Student Welfare Officer Oliver Tsingos, or any of us on the Union Board. We always take such situations seriously, and we want you to feel safe and welcome.

We know there can be a lot to digest during the first few weeks—a new university, new friends, new activities—but we at the Union are here to help you through it all. Our class mentors will be available from day one to support you and your class. In addition to them, we also have plenty of bonus mentors who are here to support you and contribute to a great atmosphere. Feel free to check out the website and our social media channels for more information and upcoming events.

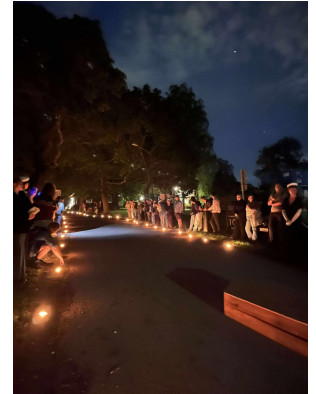
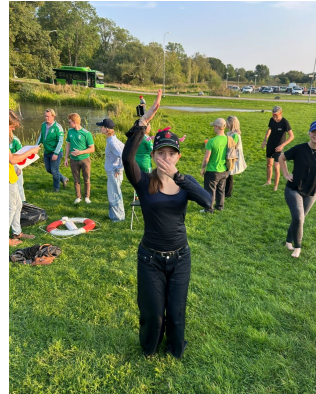

The songbook dinner september the 5th

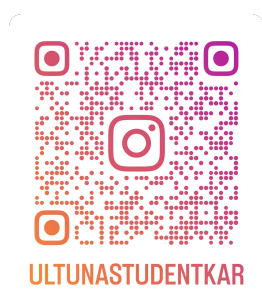

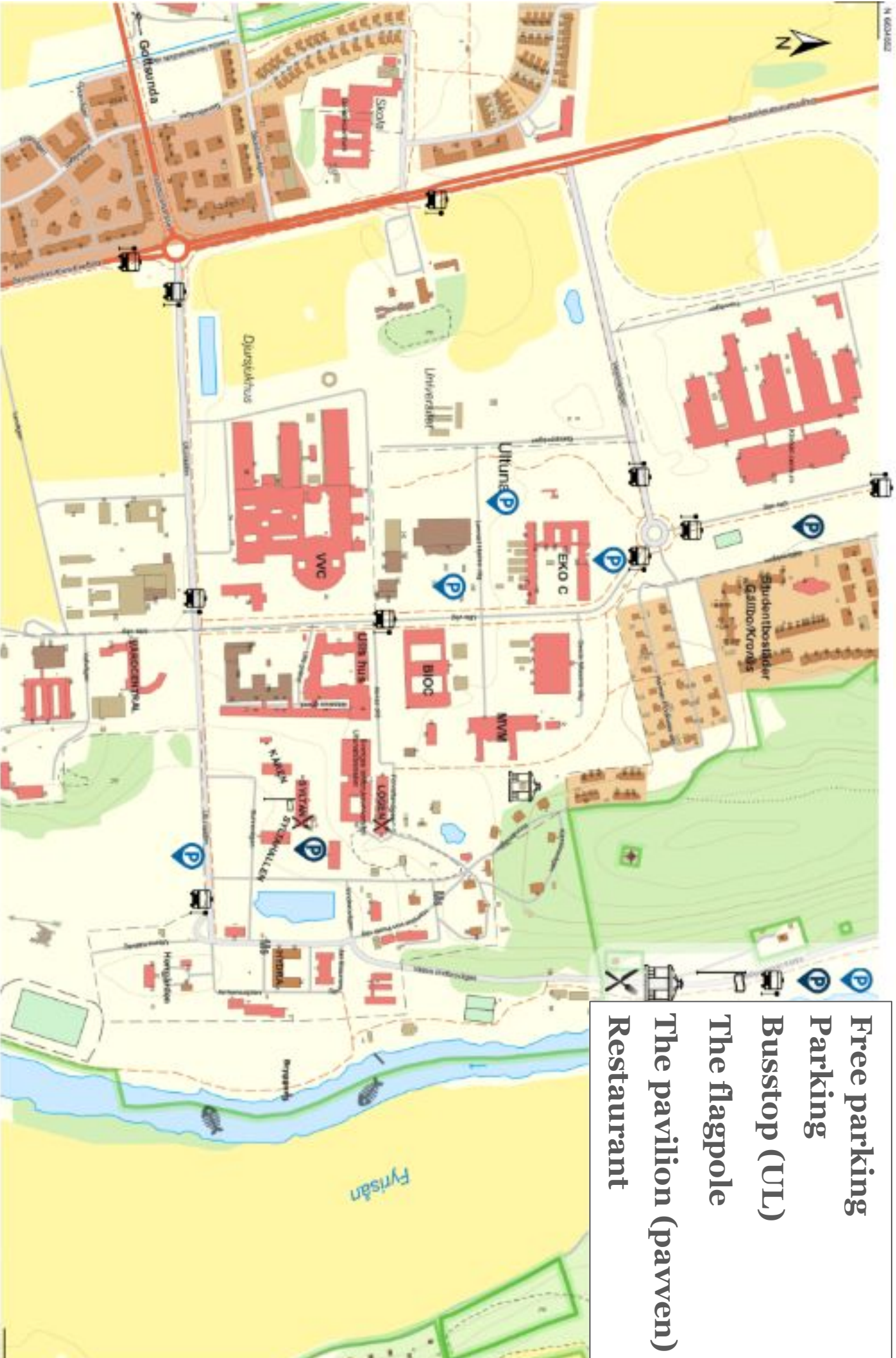
This is your last night as a *småtting* and the start of the sweet life as a wise Ultuna student (*hvisa Ultunesare*)!

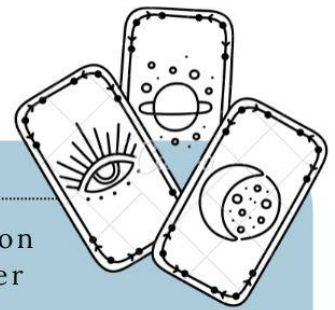

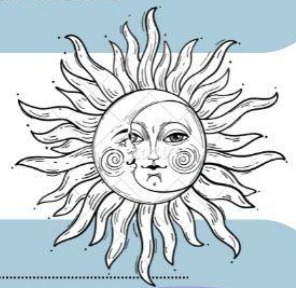

ULS Union



Ultuna Student Union (ULS) is a student-run organization built on three core pillars:

- **Educational monitoring:** by representing student voices to SLU, ULS works to ensure that the education maintains high quality.
- **Career relations:** through corporate contact and the brokerage of jobs and internships, ULS works to simplify the students' transition to professional life.
- **Social student environment:** through activities, social events, and opportunities to get involved in the Union's various committees, ULS works to provide students with an enjoyable time studying and a chance to make valuable contacts.

The Union's operations are divided into different committees with specific areas of responsibility. The Union's highest decision-making body is the Union Meeting, which is held five times a year. It is at the Union Meeting that members are elected to various positions within the committees. At the November Union Meeting each year, a new board is elected, consisting of nine positions, three of which work full-time at the Union: Union President, Vice Union President, and Union House Manager.

Ultuna Student Union's Alcohol and Drug Policy

To ensure that everyone has a pleasant experience at the Union during party activities, please keep these points in mind!

From the Party Policy:

- During party activities arranged by the Ultuna Student Union, entrance to the union house takes place via a staffed entrance. Failure to comply with this will result in suspension from the Ultuna Student Union's party activities.
- If fighting, altercations, threats, or discrimination against party participants or staff occur during the Union's party activities in the union house or in another venue where the union's party activities take place, suspension from the Ultuna Student Union's party activities will follow.
- Outside alcohol, narcotics, or other intoxicants intended for abuse may not be brought into the Union House or Ulls Restaurant premises. Consumption of these and/or possession of narcotics will result in the individuals concerned being evicted from the premises.

From the Alcohol and Drug Policy:

- Moderation shall prevail when serving alcohol, and the service of alcoholic beverages shall be refused to noticeably intoxicated persons.
- Persons who are noticeably intoxicated, under the influence of narcotics, or suspected of abusing other intoxicants shall not be admitted to the Union House or Ulls Restaurant premises.

Don't forget that you must be able to show a valid ID and be over 18 years old to participate in our activities where alcohol is served!

Ultuna Student Union's core values

Below is a summary of the Ultuna Student Union's core values. To view the core values in their entirety, you can visit the website, ultunastudentkar.se, or ask a union official for help.

The following guidelines are set out in the Union's core values:

- that all members and participants in ULS activities must actively distance themselves from discrimination and work to create an environment where everyone is included on equal terms.
- that ULS shall work against discrimination related to study program, length of study, union involvement, and language skills.
- that ULS shall design its activities so that everyone has the opportunity to participate to the greatest extent possible, regardless of ability, background, and affiliation. All operations are based on voluntariness and inclusion. This means that all committees, associations, and members shall actively work for complete inclusion during events, activities, and other operations.
- that everyone who visits and operates on Campus Ultuna has the opportunity to express opinions and influence the social environment they are part of.
- that all members and participants in ULS activities share a responsibility to create a safe environment, as well as to counteract rumor-mongering and harassment at ULS and on campus, where everyone should feel welcome and thrive.
- that all members of ULS have the opportunity to influence and voice their opinions regarding the Union's operations and traditions, and are aware of this possibility.
- that the ULS Board and committees are tasked with addressing the views and feedback presented by participants in the organization's activities.
- that the ULS Board, in cooperation with the Equal Treatment Committee (*Likabehandlingsutskottet / LikeU*), has a responsibility to continuously work with equal treatment issues within its own organization.
- that opinions and proposals for changes to the core values should be directed to the ULS Board or the Equal Treatment Committee.

Support and action

Those who have experienced discrimination or harassment have the opportunity to seek support and assistance from ULS. In the event of a violation of these core values or ULS's governing documents, ULS shall seek dialogue with the parties involved so that ULS receives a clear background to the problem and can offer support. This is because ULS believes that positive change occurs through dialogue between people. ULS should take measures against those who are unwilling to listen. Actions that can be taken against an individual student by ULS are described in the statutes and policies.

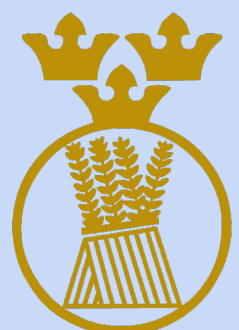

ULS Committees

Bastuutskottet (BastU) manages the sauna in Syltahallen and saunas.

Ceremoni- och traditionsutskottet organizes a celebration and ball for all graduates and manages the history of the Corps, which includes, not least, flags, cannons and the Corps' grave.

Controllerenheten keeps a constant eye on the Union's finances and acts as support to the Union's various treasurers.

Fadderiet During the welcome weeks, we ensure that all new students receive the best possible welcome to SLU, Ultuna and the Student Union.

Fikautskottet (FiQ) bakes and organizes café at the Union at regular intervals. Also bakes for various orders and events.

Grammofonnämnden (GN) Responsible for sound and lighting during parties.

Hantverksutskottet (HantU) a gathering place for all creative souls in Ultuna that organizes craft meetings, workshops and crafts with coffee.

Hållbarhetsutskottet works with environmental issues within the Union and at SLU.

Spelutskottet (SpelU) organizes game nights at the Union and online events.
